Overview:

This seminar will provide an overview of basic growth characteristics and environmental adaptation of cool-season turfgrasses, before examining more advanced topics, such as:

- Major environmental stresses that cause performance decline
- Physiological reasons behind stress injury to turf
- Advanced management strategies to prevent stress injury
- Maintaining high quality turf when water quality and quantity concerns exist
- Best management practices for common, real-world problems

Dr. Bingru Huang

Bingru Huang, Ph.D., is a professor at Rutgers University. Bingru teaches plant physiology and conducts research in the areas of turfgrass stress physiology and management. She co-authored the book "Applied Turfgrass Science and Physiology" and recently edited "Plant Environment Interactions." She has published over 150 articles in environmental stress physiology and turfgrass stress management.

Dr. Jack D Fry

Jack D. Fry, Ph.D., has been a professor in the Division of Horticulture at Kansas State University since 1991. He recently co-authored the textbook, "Applied Turfgrass Science and Physiology." Jack teaches courses in turfgrass management and golf course operations and conducts research in environmental stress physiology, integrated disease management, and turf establishment. He has served industry associations in numerous capacities, including as the 2004 chair of division C-5 (Turfgrass Science) of the Crop Science Society of America.
